Park Manor Personal Care Home was opened in 1967 as a service of the Seventh-day Adventist Church to provide holistic long-term care for the residents of Transcona, Winnipeg and surrounding communities.

“Offering love, peace, compassion, hope and empowerment...to CARE as Christ does” is our mission statement and as an accredited long-term care home we are committed to caring about our people, our quality and our resources. A “Resident’s Bill of Rights” and Resident/Family Counsel help us to uphold the dignity and worth of each person who comes to live with us.

Park Manor Care is a non-profit registered charity receiving funding assistance from the Manitoba Government. We comply with Provincial legislation and regulations pertaining to long term care health facilities. Our name was changed in January of 2015 to: Park Manor Care Inc.

Additional Services

Park Manor Care provides these additional services to the community:

- Meals-on-Wheels
- Adult Day Program
- SSGL Program (*supports to seniors at 2 apartment buildings in Transcona*).

Some services are provided to Park Manor residents by outside agencies including:

- occupational therapy
- psycho-geriatric assessments
- counseling
- podiatry
- optometry
- spiritual programs
- hairdressing

East Park Lodge

Park Manor Care also operates East Park Lodge—an attached senior’s apartment building, with limited emergency medical assistance, plus we offer meal service to East Park Lodge tenants.

Facility and Services

Our current capacity is 100 residents; 44 private, 20 semi-private and 4 four-bed rooms. We strive to provide an atmosphere as close to that of home as we can by allowing residents to personalize their rooms with selected furnishings and pictures/mementos whenever possible.

A multi-disciplinary team aims at maximizing the well being of our residents by developing an individual resident care plan that encompasses the physical, social, spiritual and emotional needs and the following services are provided: medical, pharmacy, nursing, recreation, rehabilitation, dietary, chaplaincy, laundry, housekeeping, maintenance, social services.

Park Manor Care has been chosen by the WRHA to build a new 120 bed addition to our present site, which we expect to begin operation in 2018.
